Thanks to the ENF Freedom Grant, we were able to give them \$1200.00 to spend on items to be shipped to our troops overseas. They were able to fill five shopping carts at the Dollar Store with a little money left over to help defray postage costs.

The annual Veterans Breakfast was held at the Lodge on November 11. Club Manager Sue Buroker and her crew of volunteers served a breakfast buffet. There were a total of 68 in attendance including veterans, families and friends, Elks, helpers and Blue Star Mothers. Members of Troop 124 of the Boy Scouts of America under the direction of Scout Leaders Jerry Haudenschield and Dennis Stockert formed the color guard and presented the flags of each branch of military service and the flag of our country.
