### **GRANT PROJECTS UPDATES**

**ENF GRANT UPDATE** 

Kenton Lodge has applied for and been approved to receive the 2023-24 BEACON GRANT.

The funds from this grant - \$4000.00 - will be split between two projects: the first is to provide two new air tanks (total cost of \$2800.00) to the Kenton Fire Department for use as desperately needed spares on their fire apparatus.

The second project will provide \$1200.00 for the purchase of cribs and car seats for the K.E.P.T. (Kinship Emergency Program of Thanks) through Heartbeat of Hardin County; this program is designed to assist grandparents/aunts/uncles who are thrown into a sudden care-giver situation for their youngest family members in an emergency situation.

With the approval of the Beacon Grant, Kenton Lodge has now received a grand total of \$12,500 from the Elks National Foundation and ENVSC for this lodge year. These funds are available to Kenton #157 because of YOUR CONTRIBUTIONS to the ENF.
