From July 1 through August 13, we are asking for donations for the Ohio Veterans Home in Sandusky, Ohio. You will find the white donation bags in a storage tub in the Trophy Room.

The most needed items requested by the residents are: NEW CLOTHING – SHIRTS, SWEATSHIRTS, SWEATPANTS – sizes L-5XL; JACKETS/ HOODIES – L-5XL; POLIDENT PURPLE DENTURE CLEANER; DISPOSABLE RAZORS (at least 3 blades or more); TISSUES; AFTERSHAVE; BODY WASH for sensitive skin; BODY SPRAY; DEODORANT; MOUTHWASH (alcohol-free); ELECTRIC RAZORS; HAIR TRIMMERS; WHEELCHAIR BAGS (these fit over the chair arm); and BATTERIES (all sizes).

The Home is currently NOT accepting used clothing, hand sanitizer, blankets, socks or books.

These bags will be collected and taken to the Ohio Elks Association Fall Reunion in Columbus, August 15, 16, and 17; from there, our State Veterans Service Chairman, Mary Beaston, will deliver them to the Sandusky Veterans Home.
